He is a graduate of Moravian College and the General Theological Seminary in New York City, and is currently enrolled in a Doctor of Ministry program at Sewanee (the University of the South). In addition to his parish ministry, Father Andrew has been active in diocesan leadership, having chaired the Liturgy and Music Committee of the Diocese of Virginia.
